

### FRIDAY, June 28, 1996

Vigil and Holy Eucharist was held in the Cathedral at 6:00 pm with The Rt. Rev. George N. Hunt, Celebrant, The Rt. Rev. Jackson E. Gilliam, Concelebrant and The Rev. Edith Sewell, Deacon.

### Call to Order

Following the service, The Rev. Morley Frech, President of the Standing Committee called the special meeting of the convention to order in Tenney Theater at 7:00 pm.

# **Quorum Report from the Credentials Committee**

Helen Hagemeyer, Chair of the Credentials Committee reported that 24 of the 72 canonically resident and domiciled constitutes a quorum in the clerical order. There being 62 clergy registered, there was a quorum established in the clerical order. Mrs. Hagemeyer further reported that, under Article III, Section 2 of the canons, that 55 of the 109 lay delegates of those parishes and missions entitled to seat and vote would constitute the quorum in the lay order. Following a standing count of the delegates from those parishes and missions entitled to seat and vote, 93 lay delegates were registered establishing a quorum present in the lay order.

The Rev. Morley Frech declared that the Convention was duly constituted and open and ready for the transaction of business.

### **Announcements**

The Rev. Canon Franklin Chun stated that the schedule for Saturday's proceedings was in accordance with the agenda which had been adopted. He reported that meditations offered by The Rt. Rev. George Hunt and The Very Rev. Peter Courtney would be offered between ballots. Coffee and pastries would be served on the lawn area between the Cathedral and the Diocesan offices.

### Recess

Following the announcements, the Convention stood in recess at 8:15 pm until Saturday, June 29, 1996. Convention would assemble in the Cathedral for morning devotions at 8:00 a.m.

### Call to Order

Following morning devotions, The Rev. Morley Frech, President Pro Tempore, called the special meeting to order at 8:15 a.m.

### Withdrawal from the Ballot

The Chair announced the withdrawal by the Rev. Mark Sisk from consideration.

### **Elections Process**

The Chair called on William Foltz, Chair of the Elections Committee, to explain the balloting procedures. Mr. Foltz announced the location of the polls in accordance with the information provided in the delegate packet. Clergy and lay delegates were assigned to separate polling stations. Those casting a ballot must report to the assigned member of the Credentials Committee at the appropriate polling station where, after being identified by the Credentials Committee, would sign for and receive a ballot. Those casting a ballot would then move to the balloting table, cast the vote, and place the ballot in the boxes so designated. Following balloting, delegates were encouraged to leave the Cathedral. Lay delegations would proceed to the polling place as a congregation, having been notified to do so by a Sergeant-at-Arms.

Mr. Foltz explained that, due to the withdrawal of The Rev. Mark Sisk, any vote cast for Fr. Sisk would be considered invalid.

Tellers were called forward and members of the Credentials Committee were asked to take their positions.

### Ballot #1

Following a period of silent prayer, the Chair announced the polls open at 8:19 am.

Sergeants-at-Arms requested the delegates to return to the Cathedral at 8:35 am, at which point, a last call for balloting was announced. The polls closed at 8:36 a.m.
